With the infants varying in age, we will be doing different things with each of them, so that we can help them with their development in gross motor skills correctly. Some of these activities will be things we will work with them on everyday such as rolling over, crawling, sitting, standing, etc. We will also include fun things into these activities such as tummy time painting, playing with blocks, etc.

We want to remind all the parents to bring in appropriate changes of clothes to put in their bens. As well as please watch out for signs of sickness so that we can eliminate the germs in the classrooms and keep the babies happy and healthy.
